


Welcome to Lyric Theatre of Oklahoma's Sensory-Friendly Performance of JAMES AND THE GIANT PEACH

I am going to the theatre to see JAMES AND THE GIANT PEACH. The theatre is named Lyric Theatre of Oklahoma at the Plaza.





I will enter the theatre through the front doors into the front lobby. The lobby is down a long hallway. It may be filled with people and noise.



I will enter into the theatre to find my seat through the large doors in the lobby. I will show my ticket to the usher and the usher will help me to my seat. I can ask the usher for help if I need anything.



I will sit with my friends and family during the show. I may sit next to someone I do not know. After I sit down, other people may need to walk in front of me to get to their seats. They may accidentally touch me. That is okay.



If I need to go to the bathroom, I will let the people I am with know. The bathroom is in the lobby.

I will know that the show is starting when a person on the stage begins talking to the audience.



There is music and sound in the show. If something is too loud, I can cover my ears, put on headphones, or hold a friend or family member's hand





If I need to take a break during the show, I will tell the people I am with. We will exit the theatre through the two exits at the back of the theatre. We can go to the lobby or the quiet room.



I know the show is over when the actors take a bow. Many people will clap for the actors and I can too. If the clapping is too loud, it is okay to cover my ears.



When it is time to leave, I will exit the theatre through the lobby. I will wait for my friends and family before I go outside of the building. We will walk to our car and go home.
