You have never walked forth with any of my brothers and sisters?

SCROOGE

I don't think I have. I am afraid I have not. Have you many brothers and sisters, Spirit?

GHOST OF CHRISTMAS PRESENT

More than eighteen hundred! One for each season of Christmas.

SCROOGE

That's a tremendous family to provide for. (All laugh and the company parades off singing.)

ALL IN HARMONY: LOVE AND JOY COME TO YOU AND TO YOU A-WASSAIL TOO, AND GOD BLESS YOU AND SEND YOU A HAPPY NEW YEAR A HAPPY NEW YEAR

SCROOGE

Spirit conduct me where you will. I went forth by compulsion with the Ghost of Christmas Past and learned a lesson which is working now. Tonight, if you have anything to teach me, let me profit by it.

GHOST OF CHRISTMAS PRESENT

(The Ghost laughs.) Touch my robe! (Scrooge does and they travel to the street.)

SCENE 2

(A few people are waiting to bring their basket of food to be cooked in the baker's oven.)

WOMAN WITH BASKET #1

Excuse me but I was here first.

WOMAN WITH BASKET #2

No you weren't. I came to the baker's first to have my goose cooked.

WOMAN WITH BASKET #1

I'll cook your goose alright if you don't let me by.

(The Ghost sprinkles them with incense and the two women begin to smile.)

WOMAN WITH BASKET #1

It's a shame to quarrel-

WOMAN WITH BASKET #2

On Christmas Day no less. Please you go first.

WOMAN WITH BASKET #1

No you first. I insist.

WOMAN WITH BASKET #2

Let's go in together.

WOMAN WITH BASKET #1

Agreed.

SCROOGE

Is there a particular flavor in what you sprinkle from your torch?

GHOST OF CHRISTMAS PRESENT

There is. Mine own.

SCROOGE

Would it apply to any kind of dinner on this day?

GHOST OF CHRISTMAS PRESENT

To any kindly given. To a poor one most.
