Will require time outside of regular evening rehearsals and performances. | |

| Job Summary: Responsible for assisting the Production Stage Manager. They should help to keeping track of cast members, sets and miscellaneous details during rehearsals and production of a stage performance as directed by the Stage Manager. During pre-production, the ASM should keep cast and crew aware of the rehearsal schedule, aid in set construction and have knowledge of what is to take place on the stage during the show. On show nights, the ASM will be on headset on stage right or stage left. They are the eyes and ears to the Stage Manger positioned in the booth. They are responsible for responding to cues, overseeing the backstage area, and supporting actors in the wings. | |
